REGULAR MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

March 31, 2015

The meeting of the Executive Council was held at the Front Street Brewery and was called to order at 12:05 p.m. by President Berger.

There was not a quorum to take any formal action, but there were extensive conversations.

Jacobs has presented a proposal to make a substantial contribution to local area law enforcement agencies for body cameras. There was lengthy conversation concerning the need of more than just cameras but the storage components and whether or not each agency would need its own or if it could be centralized. The issues of maintenance and suppliers were just several of the issues. Sommers agreed to be in contact with Jacobs and they would try to contact local law enforcement agencies and determine their needs and their priorities. It was then suggested if we are making substantial contributions there might be other ideas such as contributions to other needs.
